
Data Back Up Made Easy!


Data back up - why do you need to do it?


man-hours of settings and customizations etc. In a flick of time you can get a personal feeling of emptiness without the data and a professional backlog.

Getting up and going again could easily cost you several days of productivity. How much is your time worth to you.


How to Backup/Restore database files?
