Setting the Date and Time

Kadex

- Press Menu, go to Options and select System Options.
- 2 Select <u>Date/Time</u>, insert the correct value and press OK to save the settings.

m-Kadex

The m-Kadex has to be connected to the software to set the date and time. Refer to the m-Kadex user manual for more details.



Enrolling Card Users

Kadex

- Press Menu, go to User Manage and select Enroll User. Select Reg RFID and press OK when you see "New Enroll".
- **2** Key in a User ID, and wave the card at the induction area until the card ID is displayed on-screen. Press OK to save.

m-Kadex

- Check that the green LED is blinking before proceeding. Then wave the administrator card twice. When the green LED blinks rapidly, wave the new user card at the terminal.
- After the beep, wave the administrator card once to end the enrollment process, or repeat the steps above to enroll more cards.



Communication Settings


